

COVID-19 Unwinding Continuity of Care: Medicaid Eligibility and Redeterminations

Dear Providers,

When the COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE) ends, an estimated five to six million people are projected to be disenrolled from Medicaid but eligible for subsidies on the Affordable Care Act Marketplaces. Many of those losing their Medicaid benefits will have health needs requiring uninterrupted care.

We are one with the DHCFP's primary focus during the unwinding which is continuity of care for our members. SilverSummit Healthplan will ensure ongoing access to providers, carrying over prior authorizations for services, and seeking to prorate or otherwise reduce deductibles for part-year coverage. Medicaid to potential Marketplace recipients can stay with the same provider with seamless transition. We also want to ensure that people who are disenrolled from Medicaid and in the middle of treatment or have other significant healthcare needs can maintain access to their critical treating provider.
